



ALGARVE FOOTBALL CUP

Regulation

Article 1:

The DF Exclusive Consultoria, Lda, will organize on 20, 21 and 22 July 2018, the **ALGARVE FOOTBALL CUP**, which will be held in accordance with the 11 football's laws.

Article 2:

Will participate in the **ALGARVE FOOTBALL CUP** the following clubs: F. C. Porto (Portugal), Everton F. C. (England) and LOSC Lille (France):

Article 3:

All the matches shall take place at the "Estádio Algarve" (Algarve Stadium), with the following schedule:

20 July 2018: F. C. Porto x LOSC Lille at 20:00

21 July 2018: Everton F. C. x LOSC Lille at 20:00

22 July 2018: F. C. Porto x Everton F. C. at 20:00

The laws of the game are contained in the Technical Regulation of the Portuguese Football Federation.

Article 4:

The teams will play all against all in "poule" system. in only one round.

Article 5:

The points shall be scored in accordance with the regulation of the Portuguese Federation's official tournaments. with 3 points for a win. 1 point for a draw and none (0) for a defeat.

Article 6:

The general ranking of the teams which at the end of the tournament are equal. shall be determined as follows. in order of priority:

- a) The number of points obtained in all matches between the teams concerned:
- b) The greatest difference between goals scored and suffered goals in all the matches of the tournament between the teams concerned:
- c) The greatest number of goals scored:
- d) The less number of suffered goals.

Article 7

If after the successive application of the criteria in the previous article still exist equal footing. will be observed the following process tiebreaker: at the end of each tournament match. will be carried out one and only one series of five kicks from the penalty mark. being assigned to each team 3 points for a win. 1 point for a draw and 0 for a loss

7.1 Keeping equal points between two or more teams. will apply. with focus on results achieved in the series of kicks from the penalty mark. the same provisions set forth in Article 6

7.2 Keeping also equality will be observed the following process, according to the priority order

a) The greatest difference between the kicks from the penalty mark marked and sustained in the series played at the end of games:

b) Increased number of kicks from the penalty mark marked in the series played at the end of games

7.3 Keeping still, equality, win the team with the lowest average age of the players used in the tournament.

Article 8

In each match 3 stops can be made, with no substitutions limit.

At half-time, may also be made all the substitutions that coaches wish to do.

Article 9

Shall be given the following special awards:

a) Trophy for the First, Second and Third Classified.

b) Trophy for the Best Player (voted by a jury composed by all the journalists who cover the Tournament).

Disciplinary Regulations

Article 10

The Trophy games will be conducted by refereeing teams appointed by the Portuguese Football Federation.

Article 11

Any situation not foreseen in this Regulation shall be decided under UEFA regulations.

Article 12

The Trophv's organization in not responsible for any accident that might occur during the event. assuming that all agents participating in the Trophv are covered by insurance stipulated by law.

Article 13

Any situation not foreseen in this Regulation shall be decided by the organization in terms of body and spirit of the Regulations of the Portuguese Football Federation.

Organizing Committee of the Tournament

Article 14

The organization created the Tournament Committee, which will be responsible for the sports development in the tournament and will have jurisdiction to resolve all disputes, claims and appeals that are not provided. This Committee shall consist of the following persons:

Article 15

If required, the Tournament Committee will prepare a report related to the tournament and send to the entities of international football (UEFA/FIFA)

Complaints and Appeals

Article 16

The Complaints and Appeals must be sent to the Tournament Committee, which will determine a final decision on the claim or appeal. The Commission will not accept any claims relating to incidents during the game and related with arbitration.

Rules of the Game

Article 17

All the matches will be played according to the laws written by the International Football Association Board (IFAB) (Edition in force), unless another way is not given in this Regulation.
